NABET-CWA/BronxNet Negotiations

The parties met in joint session at the library at Lehman College in the Bronx. The bargaining session began with the Union's Committee going through all of the open items in the proposed collective bargaining agreement.

An agreement was reached on a formula for the part-time employees of BronxNet to accrue a maximum of 3 paid vacation days and 3 paid sick days in a calendar year. The Union and BronxNet representatives then exchanged proposals on the economic terms of the contract.

After several caucuses the Union presented BronxNet with an overall package proposal on wages; that if acceptable, would bring about a Tentative three year Agreement with a unanimous recommendation for ratification from your Negotiating Committee. BronxNet Executive Director Michael Knobbe needed time to review the Union's latest offer and the parties agreed to meet on March 21, 2008 at Lehman College. It is the goal of your Committee to finally wrap up these negotiations at that session.
