Nominating petitions for candidates to be delegates to the 2001 63rd Annual CWA Convention will be available at the Local 11 office, 888 Seventh Avenue, Suite 911, New York, NY 10106 as of Friday, March 23, 2001. They are available via mail or in person. The Convention will be held in Minneapolis, Minnesota from July 9th through July 10th, 2001.

In accordance with Article II, Section 2.6(b) of the Local 11 By-Laws, to be eligible to run for delegate, a member must be active continuously in good standing in the Union for no less than one (1) year at the time of their nomination.

Petitions must contain signatures (and printed names) of not less than twenty (20) active members in good standing in the Local as of the date petitions are due. These original petitions, along with an optional brief biography (Section 7.3(C) of the Local By-Laws), must be in the Union Office by 5:00 PM, Friday, April 20, 2001. Do not return via fax!!!

The election will be by secret ballot, conducted by the American Arbitration
