RE: NBC Anthrax Case

NBC announced today that an employee who works in the NBC Nightly News office on the 3rd Floor at 30 Rock, has contracted Anthrax.

The Company has notified the appropriate authorities and agencies, and a full investigation is ongoing.

As a precautionary measure, the NYC Department of Health has set up a testing site on the Mezzanine at 30 Rock, starting today and continuing through Monday, October 15, 2001, for employees to be tested for Anthrax. We have not received a testing schedule as of today, but please check with your regular work stations for further information.

We encourage all members who have any concerns to be tested.

Additionally, a telephone hot line has been established by the NYC Department of Health. That number is 1-877-817-7621.
