## RE: NBC Anthrax Situation

A meeting was held this morning at NBC to discuss our concerns about the ongoing anthrax situation at 30 Rockefeller Plaza. Representatives from NABET-CWA Local 11, AFTRA, DGA and IATSE, as well as several Company senior management representatives attended this meeting. Because of the breaking anthrax situation at CBS, representatives from the Department of Health and the CDC were unable to attend this meeting. A follow up meeting with those medical officials was requested by all the Union representatives.

Several key pieces of information was made available to us by NBC's spokesperson JIM Mills.

1. Every NBC employee who was tested for exposure to Anthrax will have their test results sent to their home.
2. No NABET-CWA-represented NBC employee will be required to be assigned on the third floor Studio Building until the appropriate medical agencies have cleared the facilities after the upcoming clean-up operation is completed.
3. The clean-up is expected to commence this weekend and will last for several days.
4. Once the cleanup is completed, medical personnel will certify that the areas are safe for our members to resume normal operations.

A follow-up bulletin will be released when additional information becomes available.
