The NBC Daily-Hire Contribution Referendum today found four of the participating NABET-CWA Locals representing Daily-Hires at NBC voting 425-to-312 in favor of increasing the employer contribution in lieu of benefits payments by five dollars (\$5.00) from \$10.00 a day to \$15.00 a day.

The tally for the individual locals showed Local 11 Daily-Hires voting 136-to-105 to increase the contribution; Local 31 voting 100-to-65 for the increase and Local 53, 165-to-114 for the increase. Local 41 voted 38 for no change with 24 votes to increase the contribution. The Union will now notify NBC of the results of the referendum supported by the majority vote cast by eligible NBC Daily-Hires which effective January 1, 2003 will now provide for employer contribution in lieu of benefits payments from the current \$10.00 to \$15.00 per day into the Entertainment Industry Flex Plan Account.

The officers of the four participating Locals want to express their appreciation to the Daily-Hires for their participation in this referendum.
