TO: All Members of NABET-CWA Local 11

**RE: January 14, 2002 notice for elections for the office of
Executive Board Member Units 2, 4&6, 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18**

Due to an error, the portion of the notice addressing SIGNATURES REQUIRED on the nominating petitions was incomplete. It should have read:

Nominating petitions for the office of Local Executive Board member must contain not less than twenty (20) signatures and printed names of members who are active members in good standing and regularly assigned to the Local Executive Board Unit involved in the election on the final day for submission of the petition. In the case of Daily Hire Members, "regularly assigned" shall mean that they have worked at least 90 working days within the 365 days prior to the due date of the petition. (Section 7.7 of the Local 11 By-Laws).

Therefore, if candidates obtained signatures from members not meeting the above requirements, these signatures may be disallowed. In this case, the candidates may have to obtain additional signatures to meet the proper requirements as stated above by the deadline of 5:00PM, Friday, February 15, 2002.
