In response to questions about when the new weekly base rates and other monies will go into effect now that the new NABET-CWA/NBC Master agreement is in place, the Union now has that information. Through the efforts of Local I 1 President Lou Fallot and based on information supplied by NBC's Director of Payroll Ron Ellis, the following is the time table as relayed to the Sector office, for payment of the new wage rates reflecting the negotiated 3% increase with all monies retroactive to March 30, 2002:

- I. All Daily-Hires who are paid weekly, will have their new rates in effect on the NBC payroll check dated tomorrow May 3, 2002.
2. All Daily-Hires will have received their new rates and all retroactive monies including Overtime and Penalty adjustments on the NBC payroll check dated May 17, 2002.
3. Staff employees will receive their new rates and straight time retroactive on the NBC payroll check dated May 17, 2002.
4. Staff employees will have all their retroactive monies, (e.g., Overtime and Penalty adjustments) by the NBC payroll check dated May 31, 2002.

The new meal per diem payments of \$52 and the increases under 7.7(b) are in effect now.

Detailed copies of the new weekly base rates for all classifications and contracts in the new Master Agreement were distributed earlier to all of the affected NABET-CWA/NBC locals.
