TO: All NABET-CWA Local 11 Active Members and Retirees

Please be advised that the applications for the Local 11 Scholarship Awards (\$500.00 per year) are now available at the Union office, 145 West 30th Street, 12th Floor. They are available via email and on the Local 11 website at www.nabetlocal11.org or by calling the Local 11 office at 212-757-3065.

The following are the eligibility requirements for the Local 11 Scholarship Award:

- 1) The Award is open to any retiree or active member of Local 11 in good standing. The member or retiree may apply for himself or sponsor a member of his immediate family, (wife, husband, son or daughter).
- 2) The applicant must presently be a fully matriculated graduate (6 or more credits) or undergraduate student (12 or more credits) at any accredited college, institute, university or any other facility of higher learning.
- 3) This Local 11 Award shall be granted only once to any applicant, but no other Award would be a cause of ineligibility.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Applicants must submit proof of present attendance at the school of higher education, i.e., copy of Fall 2020 or Spring 2021 Bursar's or Registrar's receipt or class schedule listing 12 credits or more (undergraduate) or 6 credits or more (graduate).
- 2) Applicants must sign the disclaimer attached to the application.
- 3) To qualify, all forms must be filled out completely.

TERMS

- 1) The Award is good for a maximum of 4 years within a 5-year continuous period and may be used in combination (if needed) of undergraduate and graduate work if the applicant has less than 4 years of undergraduate work remaining and is accepted for graduate study.

METHOD OF SELECTION

- 1) The winner or winners shall be drawn by lot.
- 2) Applications must be received at the Local 11 office no later than 5:00 PM, Friday, February 12, 2021.

The annual NABET-CWA Memorial Scholarship applications are available at the Local 11 office via email, on the Local 11 website at www.nabetlocal11.org or by calling the office at 212-757-3065. They are also available on the NABET-CWA website at: <https://www.nabetcwa.org/news/first-application-nabet-cwa-memorial-scholarship-awards>

The eligibility requirements for the scholarship are:

1. The scholarship is open to all active members in good standing, active retirees, and their sons and daughters who are either in, or about to enter, an accredited college or trade school.
2. Applicants who are in high school must be graduating in 2021.
3. Six (6) scholarships will be awarded. Each award is a one-time \$1000.00 payment to be used for tuition or other expenses to the school designated by the winner.
4. There are two parts to the application's process. The first, is an application of interest. Second, once we have received the application and the member has been verified to be in good standing, the applicant will receive the second application, which will include an essay and will require a completed academic record.

The return date for the first application is February 16, 2021. The return date for the second application is April 30, 2021. All applications must be verified by the Local President, in the space provided before mailing to the Sector office at NABET-CWA, 501 Third Street NW, 6th Floor, Washington, DC 20001.
